- All the poster submission shall be accepted but **NOT** after the said date (10.09.2026) of submission

#### GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION:

- It can be individual or group research projects but only one author can present and the same will receive the participant certificate.
- Submission of abstract is suffice. It shall be adhered to IMRaD format.
- Do restrict to MS word format: Times New Roman, Size 12, Space 1.5, and Word Length 500.
- Do attach declaration letter stating the work is original and not presented/published anywhere.
- Plagiarism report is mandatory.
- Authors can submit their abstracts through an email attachment to [cconwebinar@gmail.com](mailto:cconwebinar@gmail.com) ONLY.
- Abstract received after the said date of submission (31.08.2026) shall **NOT** be entertained.
- The review committee selects a maximum of 15 papers for presentation after the scrutiny.
